

1 **HOST A KICK-OFF EVENT**

3 **HOST A SPEAKER**

Either someone local (i.e. from a Pregnancy Center) or a nationally known pro-life speaker, such as Serrin Foster of Feminists for Life. Get someone to come to help educate your campus. Be sure to publicize it well!

4 **COLLABORATE WITH LIKE-MINDED GROUPS**

Contact other campus groups that might be interested in the pro-life message. Examples may be: Newman Center, Campus Crusade for Christ, Inter-Varsity, College Republicans, Democrats for Life etc.

5 **TABLING ONCE A MONTH**

Have a table in your student center or near a dining hall and make literature available. Have at least two folks there so you can engage questions and educate your peers!

6 **ATTEND MARCH FOR LIFE AS A GROUP**

7 **WORK WITH A CRISIS PREGANANCY CENTER**

9 **PUBLICIZE!**

- Post fliers around campus monthly to get the word out and get people thinking.
